

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First Eurozone Conference

addresses Prospects and Future Scenarios

The Italian Chamber of Commerce in cooperation with the Irish Chamber of Commerce in Slovakia, Dutch Chamber of Commerce, Spanish Chamber of Commerce and French Chamber of Commerce held its first EuroZone Conference on 23 May at Hotel Double Tree By Hilton Bratislava.

The topic, Prospects and Future Scenarios, was covered by distinguished guest speakers, Ms Elena Kohutikova, Deputy CEO VUB Bank, Mr. Juraj Karpiš, co-founder of the Institute of Economic and Social Studies in Bratislava ((INESS) and Mr. Zoltan Pogatsa, University of Western Hungary.

Over the course of the conference, the speakers shared their visions on the current euro crisis, potential solutions and future perspectives of the eurozone, followed by a panel discussion and Q&A session whereby the participants were given the opportunity to interact and engage in dialogues with the speakers. The conference was moderated by Ivan Šramko, Advisor to CEE and SEE Operations, Intesa SanPaolo and former governer of the National Bank of Slovakia.

The conference mainly focused on the issue of Greece in the euro area, viewed by some as a "unique case" while Ireland was referred to as "success story ",on the right road to recovery.

Regarding possible solutions to the current crisis, it was generally agreed that introducing structural reforms, which would revive the economies of the member states, are the main solutions to the current crisis.

The conference was attended by around 70 people.
